



Reminder: Parking and Drive- Thru Procedures

Parents using the Drive-Thru for dropping off their child/children are reminded to move to the front of the Drive-Thru Zone. Cars stopping close to the office cause traffic to build up on Amherst Road.

Likewise **those using the crosswalk are asked to allow a number of cars to join the cue before crossing** as this also allows traffic to move through the Drive-Thru and off Amherst Road.

A notice for parents of children who ride or walk to school
