

YEAR 2'S CULTURAL BACKGROUND ORAL CLASS PRESENTATION

Dear Families,

In Term Three, as a part of our Guided Inquiry into multiculturalism, we will be exploring the many different cultures that exist in our classroom.

The children have been asked to choose one culture reflecting the country of birth of themselves, parents or grandparents (this can be 'Australian' if necessary). They will then need to plan a one to two minute presentation about their chosen culture, explaining three things they know or have learnt.

Their presentation may include information about:

- clothing
- food
- money
- music
- dance
- special celebrations
- significant monuments or buildings



The children may write down some dot points to refer to, though ideally they will rehearse the skills of being able to speak to an audience without simply reading out a pre-written script. They may also bring in a small number of items or photographs to help explain the different aspects of their chosen culture. All presentations must be ready to be delivered by Monday 7 August (Week 4).

You are also asked to please complete the form at the bottom of this page and send it back to school with your child. This information will be used within our classroom to identify the range of cultures that are represented and to plan a timetable for presentations.
