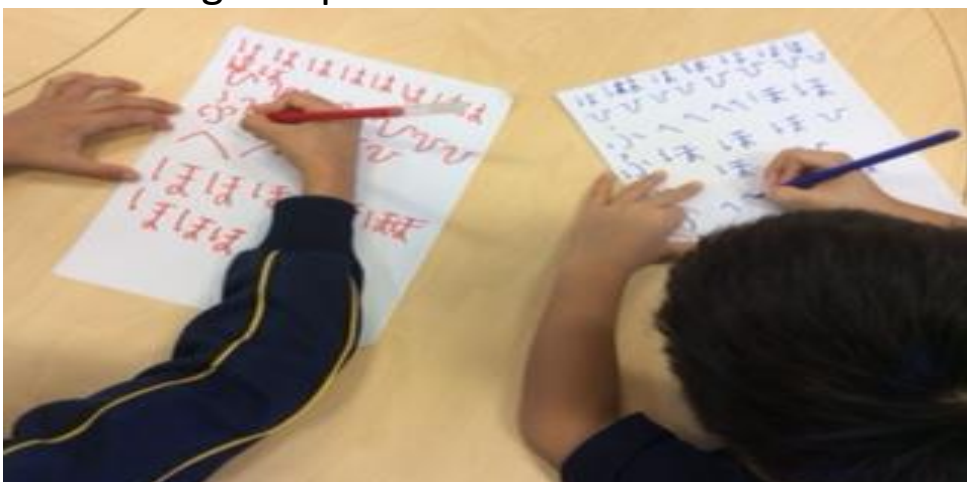

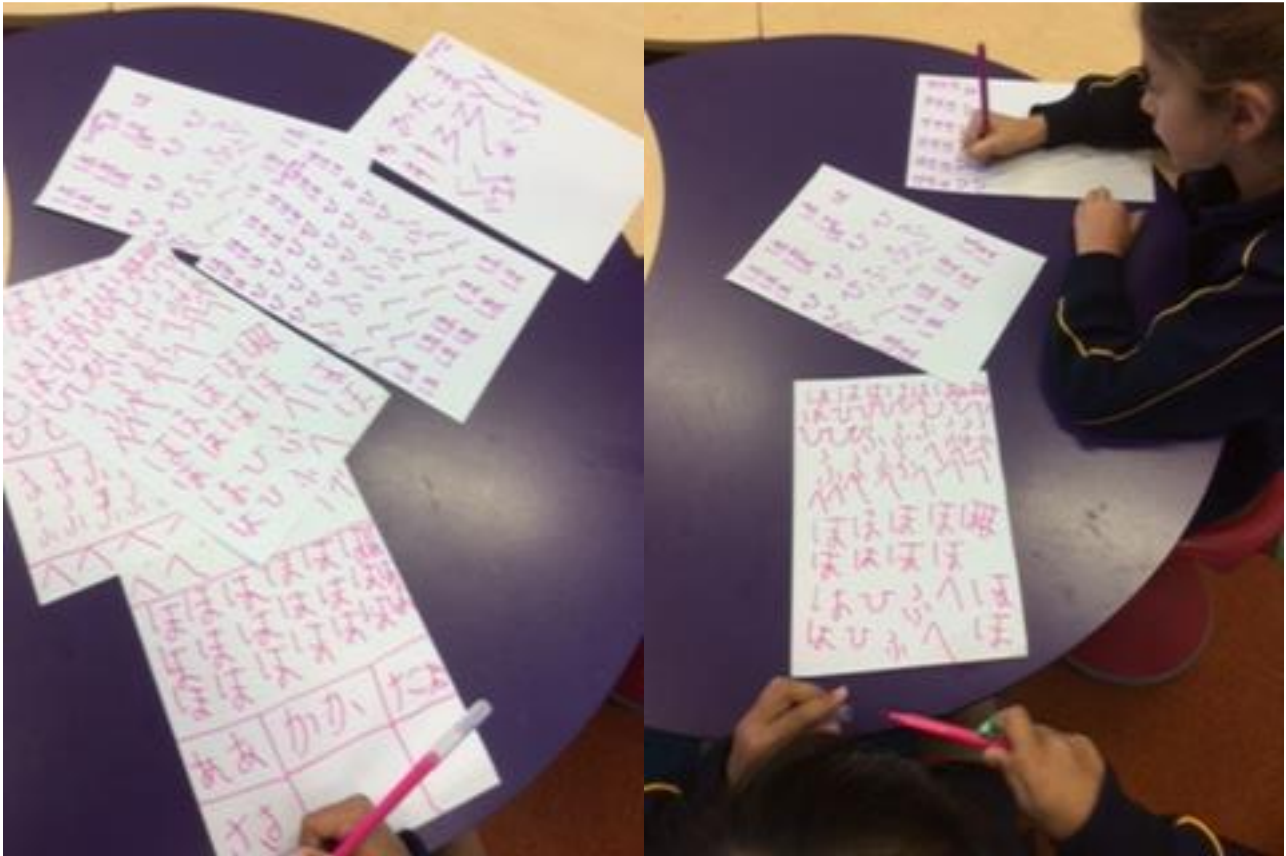
We are now looking at all things school!

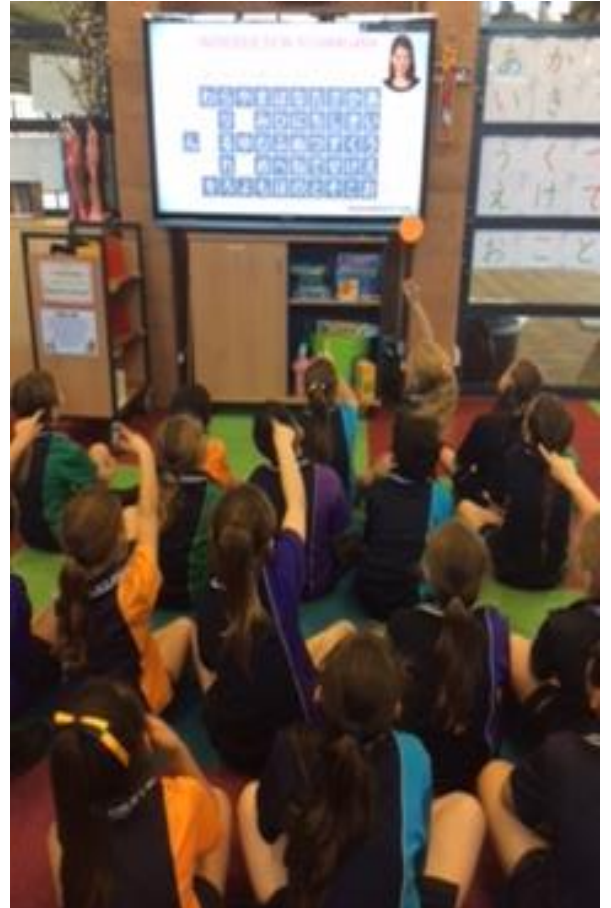
