

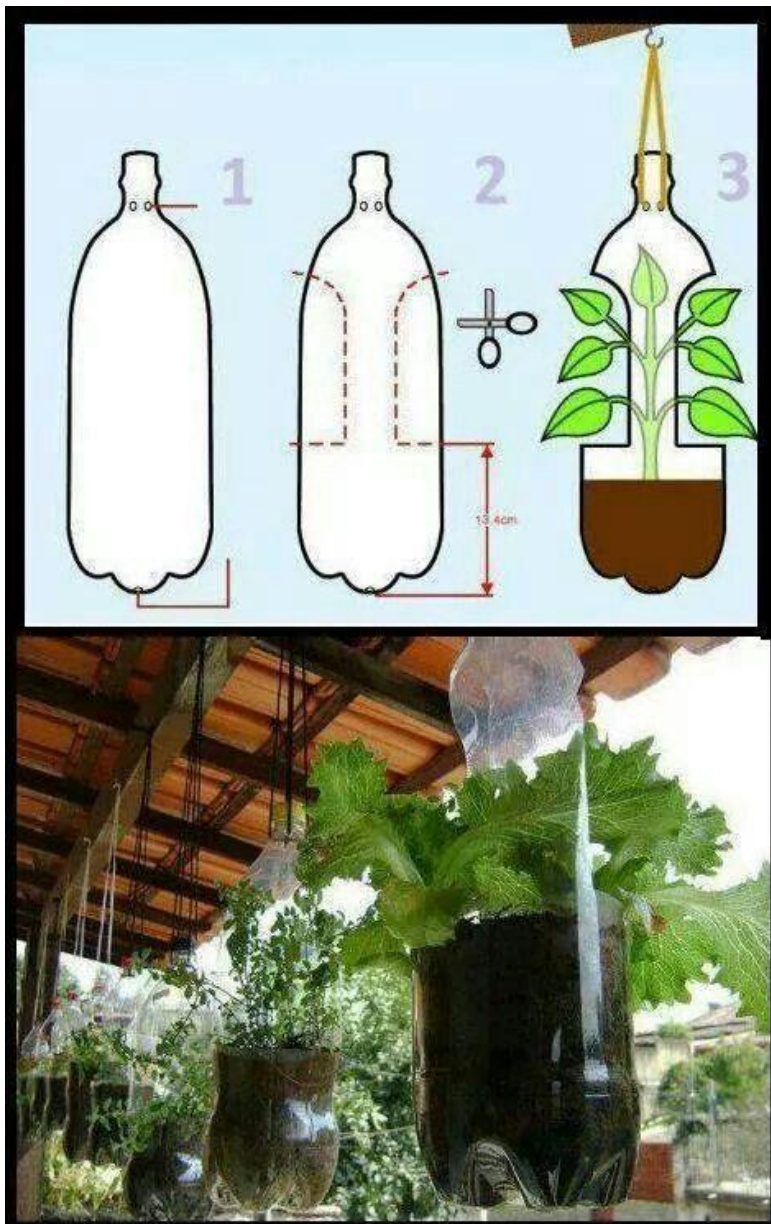
Year 2 Science Activity – Term 3 2017

In Term 3 the students will be learning about 'Future Earth', which is the 2017 National Science Week theme.

The Year 2 students will be looking at kitchen gardens for the smaller living habitats that humans will be experiencing in our future.

To prepare ourselves for the activity, each child will need to bring to school one empty 1 litre or 2 litre soft drink bottle. A parent will need to prepare the bottle for their child.

Here is a diagram below and you will need to cut away the plastic to create a space for planting.



You will need to measure 14 cm from the base of the bottle before you cut away the plastic. The 14cm area will be where the children put the soil and plant their seeds.

You will also need to use a drill to make a drainage hole in the base of the bottle.

If your child would like to be able to hang up their planter when it is brought home then you will also need to drill some holes in the neck of the bottle so that we can thread some string.

Once your bottle is ready please put your name on it and bring it to school.

We will commence this project early in Term 3.
