Dear Families,

In Week 5 of this term, on **Monday 14th and Tuesday 15th August** our school will be involved in a **School Cyclical Review (SCR)**, which is a process that comes along once every **five years** in the life of a school.

The Review involves engaging key stakeholders from our school community in a strategic conversation about our school's **improvement journey** with a panel of educators, external to our school. Upon completion of the Review we will have met Western Australian compliance of school re-registration regulations, in a process that promotes a culture of reflection, collaborative inquiry and shared responsibility for continuous improvement at both our school and system level.

The SCR process consists of five steps – planning, preparation, school visit, reporting & analysis. We have prepared a **Self-Review Statement** which will be used by the panel to refer to when meeting with the Leadership Team, staff, students, and members of the Board and P&F.
