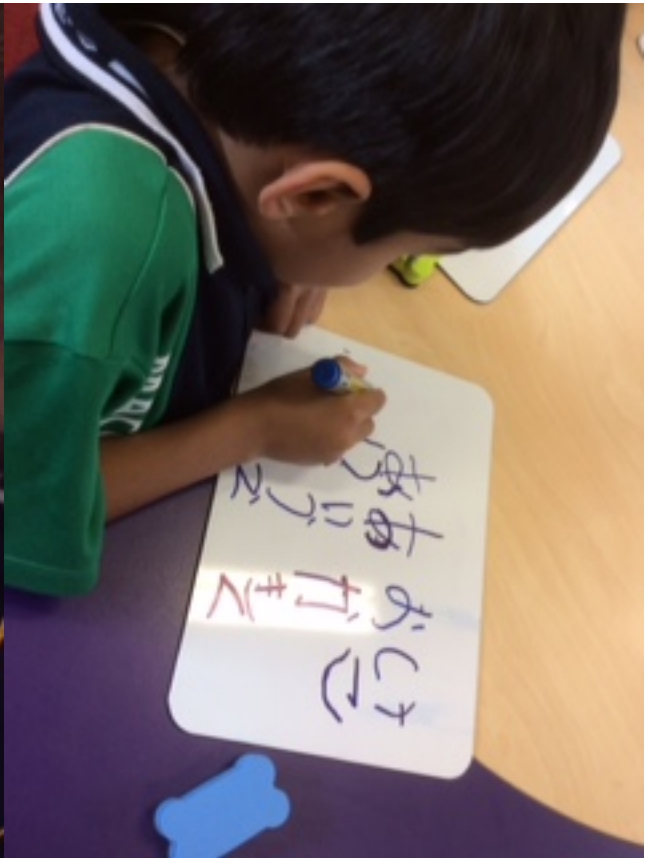
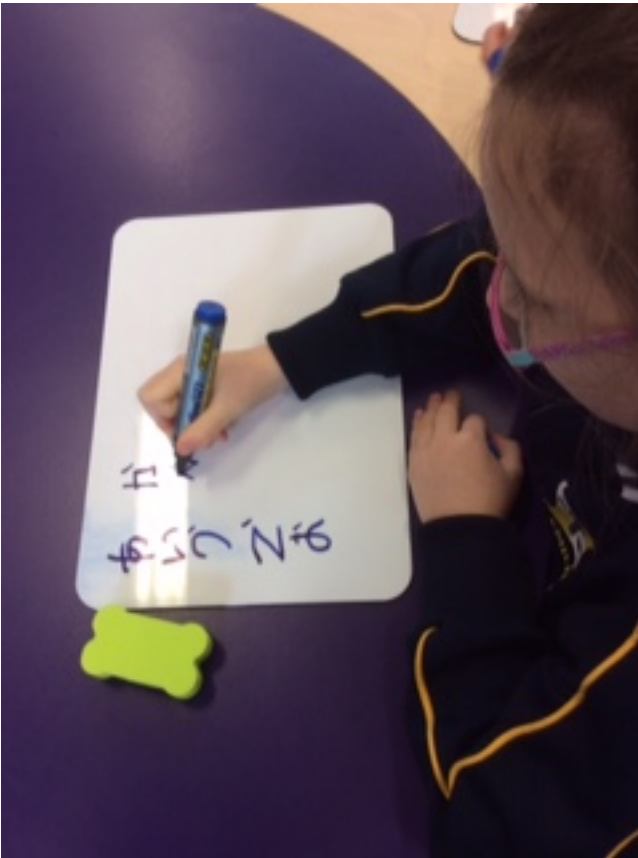




Our year One, Two and Three classes are also becoming more confident in writing and reading their Hiragana characters and enjoy working in our small group activity stations during our classes.
