### **Drinks: What Should Children Drink?**

Drinking plenty of water is essential for people of all ages. When your child is thirsty, encourage them to drink plain water. It is recommended that children aged 5 - 8 years drink 1000 ml per day (4 big cups), children aged 9 - 12 years drink 1500ml per day (6 big cups) and young people aged 13+ years drink 2000ml per day (8 big cups). Drinking milk is also important, as it provides children with the calcium they need for growing bones and teeth. If your child doesn't drink milk, try yoghurt, cheese or calcium-fortified soy milk. The drinking of cordials, soft drinks and fruit juices should be limited, as the sugar in these drinks may contribute to tooth decay and unhealthy weight.
