For Your Information: Funeral Next Tuesday

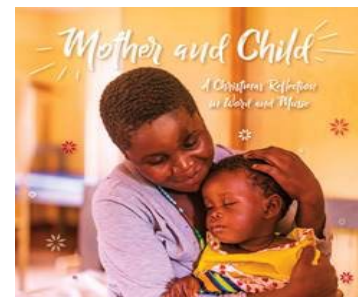

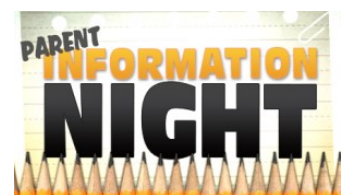
