Information for parents of children in Years 3, 4 and 6

Please note that children are not to be dropped off to school before **8:20am** as there is no supervision provided before this time. If children arrive at school at 8:20am, they are to stay with their parents outside their classroom and sit quietly. From 8.20am they are to sit in the Undercover area with a staff member. **Children are not permitted to run around or play on playground equipment before school.** Classroom doors open at 8:30am and the school day starts at 8.40am. If you need to drop your child off earlier than 8:20am, you are asked to utilise our **OSHClub service** for before and after school care.
