These units of work aim to develop the students social and emotional learning skills as well as their Personal and Social capability.

The chart on page 2 demonstrates how the five types of social and emotional learning skills identified through Friendly Schools research relate to the four organising elements of the personal and social capability learning continuum in the Australian Curriculum.

Year 1&2 students will be covering topics such as Bullying, Making Choices & Feelings

Year 3&4 students will be covering topics that include: Choices & Consequences, Perseverance and resolving conflict.

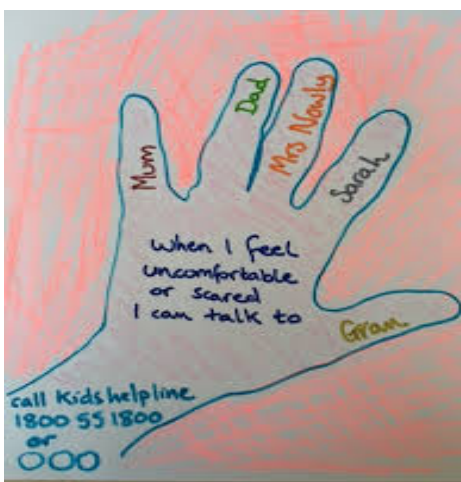
Year 5&6 students will cover Bullying, Friendship Groups & Decision Making

PROTECTIVE BEHAVIOURS

Teaching Protective Behaviours is mandated in all schools.

The curriculum follows two main themes:

- We all have the right to be safe
- We can help ourselves to be safe by talking to people we tru



This Term all year groups will be covering 4 aspects of the Protective Behaviours Program

1. **Rights and responsibilities** - Children's Rights
2. **Identity & Relationships** – Healthy & Unhealthy relationships, Gender Stereotypes
3. **Power in Relationships** – Bullying, Types & Use of Power, Tricks and Bribes
4. **Trust & Networks** – Developing a trusted network
