Bishop's Religious Literacy Assessment for Years 3 & 5

Year 3 and 5 students in Catholic schools across WA will take part in the Bishops' Literacy Assessment (BRLA). The BRLA, which is completed online, does not assess a student's faith. Rather, the BRLA provides a 'point in time' snapshot of student performance in Religious Education. Students' knowledge and understanding of the content in the Religious Education curriculum is assessed using a combination of multiple choice, short and extended response items.
