### ***Pupil Free Day: Monday 20th August***

A reminder that there is a pupil free day on **Monday 20th August** for Catholic Day. School will resume on **Tuesday 21st August**.

### ***Feast of the Assumption Mass: Time Change***

The Feast of the Assumption Mass is next **Wednesday 15th August** at **1:30pm**.

### ***Bishop's Religious Literacy Assessment for Year 3***

Year 3 students in Catholic schools across WA will take part in the Bishops' Literacy Assessment (BRLA) next **Thursday 16th August**. The BRLA, which is completed online, does not assess a student's faith. Rather, the BRLA provides a 'point in time' snapshot of student performance in Religious Education. Students' knowledge and understanding of the content in the Religious Education curriculum is assessed using a combination of multiple choice, short and extended response items.

### ***First Holy Communion - Year 4 Families***

Year 4 First Holy Communion Masses will be held this **Saturday 11th August (6:30pm)**, **Sunday 12th August (9am or 5pm)** and next **Saturday 18th August (6:30pm)** and **Sunday 19th August (9am or 5pm)**. Please note it is very important that children attend on the Mass date and time that families have nominated.



### ***Two/Three Way Interview Day: Wednesday 22nd August***

Two-Way (Parent/Teacher) interviews for Kindy to Pre-Primary and Three-Way (Parent/Teacher/Student) interviews for Year 1 to Year 6 will be held all-day on **Wednesday 22nd August**. Kindy and Pre-Primary interviews will be held in the Learning Hub, Year 1 to 3 interviews will be held in the MPR and Year 4 to 6 interviews will be held in the Library.

### ***NAPLAN Online Trial***

You may have heard that NAPLAN Online was introduced in 2018, with 274 WA schools participating. Our school will be transitioning to NAPLAN Online in 2019. This online trial will enable us to assess our technical readiness to implement the new online assessments. In addition, it will give us a chance to try out the new national online assessment platform in a real-life classroom environment. Next week on **Monday 13th August and Tuesday 14th August**, some Year 3 & Year 5 students will participate in a trial of the assessment platform, by undertaking online readiness tests that includes examples of the new NAPLAN online questions. These tests will take about 45 minutes each to complete. The tests have not been constructed to assess curriculum knowledge, but rather to provide students with an opportunity to experience the types of questions that will be included in the new online assessments. As such, reports will not be provided.

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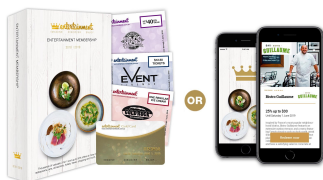
