

REMINDERS - COLOUR RUN INFO



DATE AND TIMING

- ❑ The **Colour Walk/Jog/Run** is to be held this coming Friday, **19th October 2018**.
- ❑ **4.30pm arrival** at school.
- ❑ **Set up your family picnic spot** in the quadrangle between Yr 3 and Yr 6 classes.
- ❑ 4.40 pm - participants to join in some **whoo hoo, warm-up exercises** - outside front of Yr 6!
- ❑ 4.45pm - Wave 1 - **families** head off (especially those with little ones and/or walkers)
- ❑ 5.00pm - Wave 2 - **children from Years 3-6** who wish to jog/run on their own or with friends.

PARKING

- ❑ Please **try to park away from the school if possible**. Cromarty gardens is a good option for many families, with only a short 5 min walk to St Emilie's.
- ❑ The Philadelphia Parade **gate will be closed**, as it will form part of the Colour Run route.
- ❑ **Any cars entering the school** must enter via the normal school entrance gate and **exit** via the Church sliding gate.
- ❑ Please be **considerate of our neighbours** and do not park across driveways or on lawns.

WHERE TO SET UP YOUR PICNIC SPOT

- ❑ Set up a picnic space **outside the front of Year 3** and the back of Year 6 classrooms, then make your way to the exercise warm up area outside the front of the Yr 6 classrooms.

THE ROUTE

1. The route is **approx 1.5 kilometres** around our school and hall grounds. While there is a map below, there will be **helpers along the route** to make sure you know where to go.
2. There are **five colour stations** along the way - these are clearly identified with signs and balloons. Colour will be thrown only by teachers, from the chest down.
3. If you do not wish to have colour thrown at you, you need to continue past the colour station and **not wear** a white t-shirt. There will signs with a black cross available at the start line to hold as you move around, indicating you **do not wish** to have colour thrown at you.
4. There will also be a few **other stations** along the way, which everyone is asked to participate in eg one station is the - 'rock, paper, scissors' station.
5. The walk/jog/run, plus pitstops for colour and activities, will take approximately 20 mins from start to finish. It isn't to be so much a 'race', as it is a leisurely stroll and a bit of family fun! :)

6. Staff will be lining the route so that it is very clear where to go so that everyone stays safe.
7. We have explained to children that when the route exits the school for a short period, the rule is - **STICK TO THE PATH!**
8. COLOURED CIRCLES = COLOUR STATIONS
 TRIANGLES = ACTIVITY STATIONS
 ARROWS = WAY TO GO!



CLOTHING

- If you and your child are joining in the COLOUR part of the fun run, you are asked to please wear a **white t-shirt** (new or pre-loved is fine).
- Optional - wear an old hat, goggles, sunnies, plastic poncho, old joggers.
- Please note that at the colour stations a little mist of water will be sprayed onto t-shirts to help the colour to stick! :)
- At the end of the Colour Run there will be buckets for everyone to wash hands.
- You may like to pack some clothes to change into (this could be done in the toilet cubicles).
