The 2019 Annual Community Board Meeting of the St Emilie's School Board will be held on **Wednesday the 21st November** immediately after the P&F AGM at **5:30 p.m.** in the Learning Hub.

This year, we have some Board members coming up for re-election and some new positions available. Members of our school community are welcome to nominate for these positions. The following description and attributes are specified by the School Board Constitution which is issued by the Catholic Education Commission of WA.

Functions of the Board

- Planning for the present and future operation of the school
- Engaging or discharging on behalf of the Bishop of the Diocese, on the recommendation of the Principal, and in accordance with guidelines issued from time to time by the Catholic Education Commission of WA, the lay teaching, auxiliary and maintenance staff required for the operation of the school.
- Providing representation on the committee, which recommends the appointment of a Principal.
- Disseminating information about the school and about Catholic education to persons and organizations in the school community.
- Liaising in all matters relating to the financial management of the school
- Managing all the finances associated with the school.
- Advising the Principal with respect to school policy that has financial implications.

Role of Individual Board Members

- Attend Board meetings and be involved in the decision making process.
- To prepare well for meetings.
- To become informed about and develop competence in all matters affecting the Board.
- To attend Board In-services.
- To provide advice to the Principal with respect to the formulation of school policy that has financial implications.
- To support the ethos of the Catholic School.

Criteria for membership of the Board shall be

- Possession of special skills that will be an asset to the Board.
- A deep interest in the welfare of students and staff.
- A desire to give service to the Catholic school community.
- A keenness to promote Catholic Education.
- An ability to work cooperatively and constructively with all other members of the Board.
- A sufficiency of time to devote to Board duties.
- To provide advice to the Principal with respect to the formulation of school policy that has financial implications.
- To support the ethos of the Catholic School.
