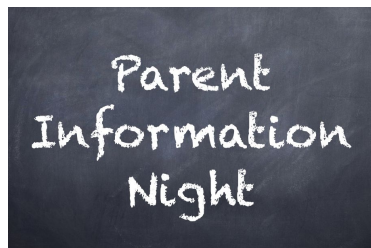
### Library Notice
