Dear Mums and Dads,

This is a really important message for you all to please take note of in regard to the ordering of food for the concert.

If you are planning to eat food (supplied by the Parish) on the night of the concert, THEN YOU MUST LET US KNOW ASAP what you're planning to buy and purchase the vouchers through the office.

As you would appreciate, Fr G needs to know HOW MUCH food to order BEFORE THE EVENT so there are no surprises on the night.

What we don't want to happen, is families lining up to buy food when they haven't indicated their food preferences.

Fr will be ordering based on the information he has been given from families before the concert night.

We really want to avoid any family missing out on the opportunity to buy the food they indicated on their skoolbag form.

However, we are also aware that some families have been saying that they will buy food vouchers and food on the night because they can't commit to what their family wants to buy.

As mentioned before, all food must be ordered through the skoolbag app NOW. If you do not have the app and would still like to order, come to the front office and we can help you.

The cutoff date has been extended until THIS MONDAY 3PM (Monday 26th November) however after this date, parents will no longer be able to order or buy vouchers.

Fr G's goal is that on the night, families that present their vouchers will get what they've ordered.

Once all families who have done the right thing have been catered for, and if there is any food left over, there will be some food vouchers available for purchase towards the end of the night.

Please appreciate that staff will be busy focusing on the concert and the parish will be focusing on the food.

Your cooperation and courtesy is expected and appreciated.
