#### Class Photos/Portraits:

**In order to ensure that lunch orders are delivered to the right class on both Wednesday and Friday, please update your child's class to their 2019 class on School Lunch Online.**

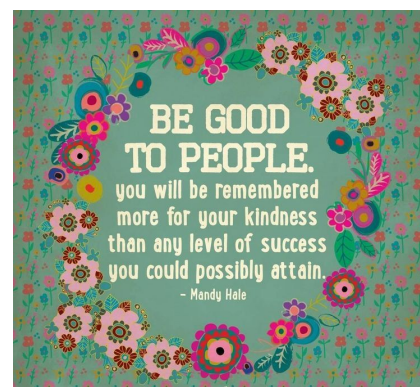
