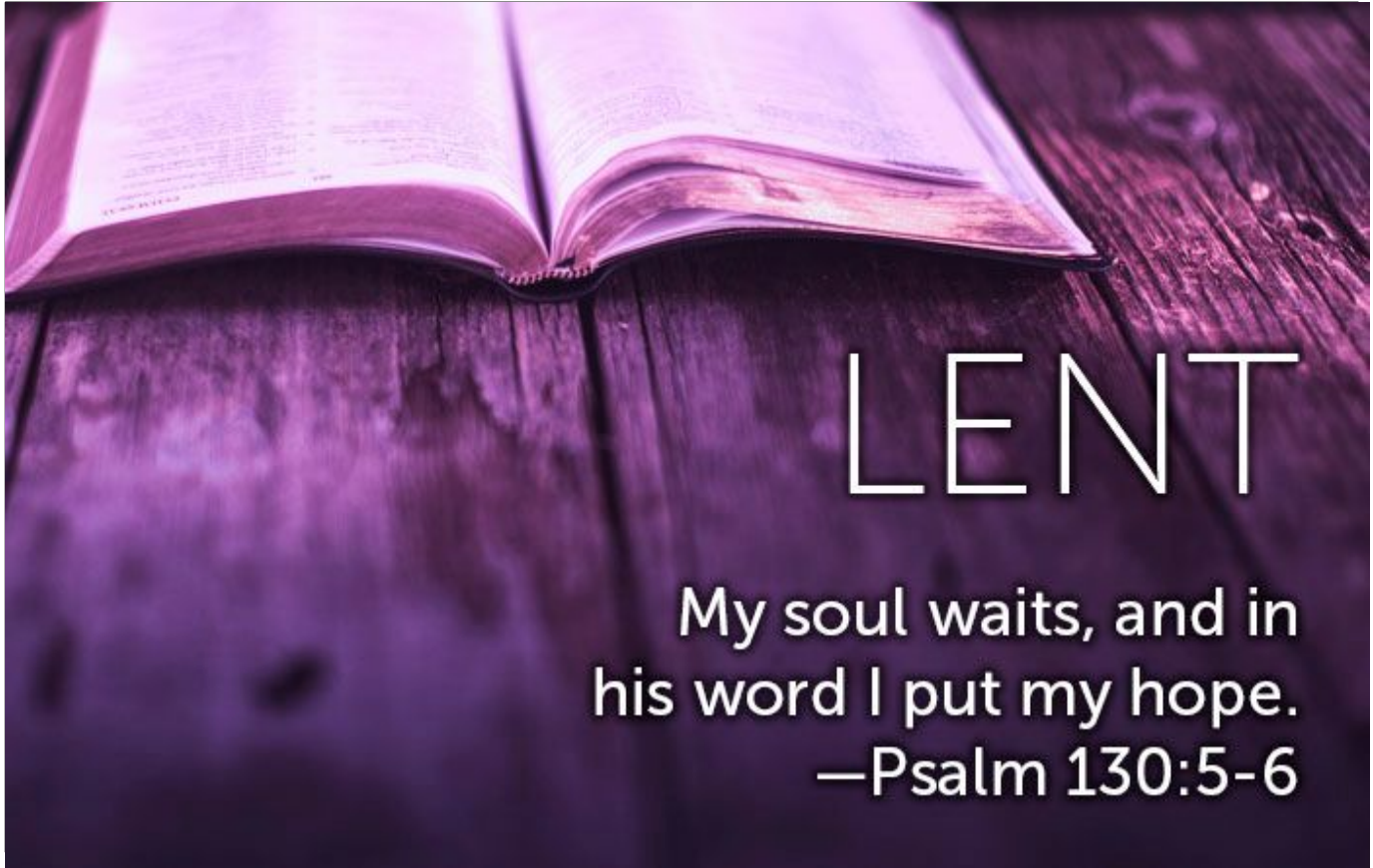

Class Photos/Portraits:

- ❖ Every Student will have their photo taken, whether they are purchasing photos or not.
- ❖ The school has chosen to use the online ordering system. Your child will be given an online ordering instruction slip and a unique student shootkey. Log onto www.msp.com.au and follow the prompts to place your order. If you lose your shootkey the school reception will have a copy to quote back to you.

- ❖ Family photos will be taken on **Thursday 14th March** in the morning before school. **For family photos, it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to take the children for the photo as it will be taken before school begins for the day. These photos will be taken in the Hall.**
- ❖ Please ensure that your family envelope and payment are handed to the Photographers on photo day.

A reminder to all parents in Kindy that the Occupational Therapy and Speech Screenings **forms must be returned at your Two Way Interview with the class teacher or to the Front Office and payments are to be made via direct deposit to each health professional (Berry Johnston and Wendy Marshall) as soon as possible, if payment has not already been made.** The reason payments are made to each health professional rather than being included in the fees is so that you may claim back a portion of the screening from your private health provider.
