



Note on Friday Assemblies and the Number of Seats Available for Parents

Dear Families,

As you will be aware our first **whole school assembly** since COVID is due to be held this **Friday the 6th August** by the **Year Four Class** in our school hall. Years 4-6 students will be in attendance at this assembly. Merit Awards are now given out in class and a photo is sent home.

As per the Government **Phase Four Guidelines**, we are writing to let families know that for us to ensure the **two square metre rule**, we can only allow a maximum of **75 parents** in the hall. Assuming that one parent from each family will attend that leaves, 15 chairs free for a few extra parents.

Unfortunately you were planning to come as a couple, or intending to bring a grandparent, we can't necessarily guarantee entry into the hall.

It will be important that every family is able to attend, if they wish. This means we need you to be as **considerate and mindful** as possible on the day.

We appreciate that decisions like this can be frustrating for parents at this time, however we appreciate your understanding of the position schools are currently in.
