Please Read Carefully

What children are to wear and bring:

- St Emilie's **House Shirt** (Gannon, MacKillop, Mazenod or De Vialar)
- St Emilie's **sport shorts**.
- **School hat** must be worn.
- **Sport shoes** for running.
- No zinc, body spray, coloured hair spray or streamers.
- Teddy/other mascots are fine (but remember it is another thing that needs to be looked after so names on things please!)
- **If your child is an asthmatic** – please make sure they have their **own puffer** (and spacer if needed).
- Children will take their labelled **Crunch and Sip** container and water bottle to the bay.
- Please note that lollies are not permitted.

Lunches:

- All children in Years 1 to 2 will have the opportunity to either bring their normal lunch or purchase a **Subway Lunch** for the day through School Lunch Online at www.schoollunchonline.com.au
- There will be a **Coffee Van** available for parents to purchase coffee and food on the day. To facilitate the smooth running of the day, this service is only to be used for **parents and younger non-school age siblings only**. It is expected that parents will be patient and respectful when using this service.

What we need from you as parents:

- Please observe the State Government Phase 4 COVID guidelines and physical distancing, good hygiene and the 2 square metre rule.

- Please note it is not acceptable to bring school aged siblings to the carnival, they are required to attend school for the day.
- Please **stay in the spectator area** (this will be clearly marked) and do not wander over (or encourage your children to wander over to you). This is very important. You and your children can talk about the excitement of the day after the carnival. Please make sure that **you have said what you need to say and given what you need to give** prior to the start of the day. This request is something we need and expect all parents to respect.
- **Do not** approach the scorers table at any time during the carnival.
- **The judge's decision is final**. No recording of races is permitted near the finish line.
- Please cheer and model the spirit of the occasion. Keep your talk positive and encouraging about children, staff, parents and our school. This is how we grow a respectful, positive and friendly community.
- The area for spectators has been separated from the pathway for children who need to visit the toilets. Children will be sent in pairs.
- Given the shorter timing of this carnival they will return to class for the remainder of the school day.
- The events on the program will take place as listed.
- Please place any rubbish in the bins / bags provided.
- If you have a few minutes before you leave we would be very grateful for **any help packing up** the tents and equipment – staff would be very appreciative!

We are anticipating that the Year One/Two Carnival will be a great day! We emphasise active participation, having a go, doing our best and being a good sport!
