

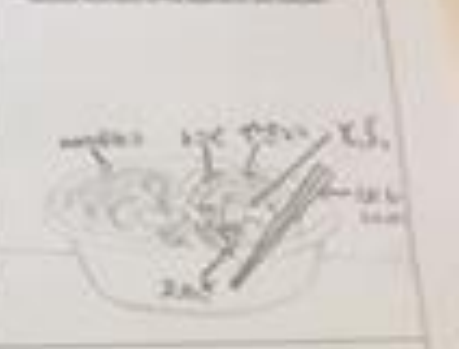
The Sukiyaki experience!
